**2 "WOW" ITEM:** Select a quality "wow" toy such as a doll, soccer ball with pump, or stuffed animal to bless a child.

**3 OTHER GIFTS:** Pack full with other fun toys, personal care items, and school supplies.

**4 PRAY:** Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your gift. Include a personal note and photo to delight the heart of a child.



**5 DONATE \$10 PER SHOEBOX:** A donation of \$10 per box is critical to cover shipping and other project costs. For easiest processing you can give online, or give by check using the attached postage-paid envelope.
