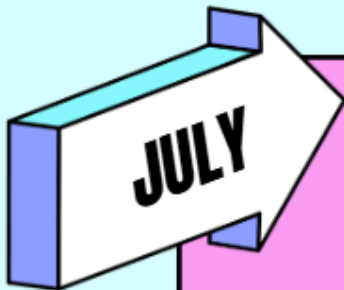

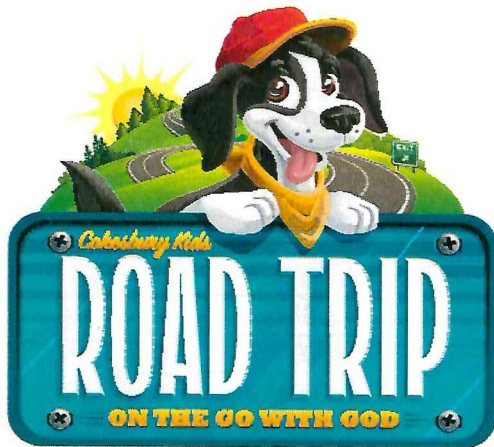

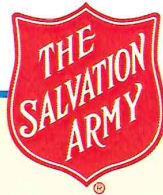

Did your child attend Hidden Falls Camp last year?

- **Please use the same email address that you used last year.** You can use the "Reset Password" link if you do not remember your password. If you do not remember which email address you used, or you wish to use a different email address, please contact us (see bottom of page) so that we can help you.
- Much of the information from last year is saved. Please review contact information to make sure it is still all correct, and the health/medication section and make any changes since last year.
- NEW: We are required to have on file the date of your child's last Tetanus shot (DTaP or Tdap).
- Make sure you review Camp Class choices with your child *before* registering so they are signed up for the classes they want. See the Parent Packet for more info.

In order to complete online registration, you will need the following info:

- Name & Phone number of at least 1 adult emergency contact besides parent(s)
- Medication name & dosage information for meds your child will take at camp
- Date of last Tetanus shot (DTaP or Tdap)
- Child's health insurance information
- Child's primary care doctor name & phone number
- Your child's choices for Camp Classes (see Parent Packet for more info)

When selecting each camp that your child will attend, you will be asked "How will your child get to camp?" **You will need to select "I will transport my child to camp."** Please do not select a Salvation Army location unless you have contacted them to verify they can transport your child. Please also know that Salvation Army locations may have different payment policies about camp and could charge more because of providing transportation.

Payment

Thanks to the generous donors to The Salvation Army, we can provide the opportunity for children to attend camp at a very low cost. For families in counties where there is no Salvation Army Corps, the cost is only \$25 per child, per camp. (If you qualify for SNAP, TANF, or free school lunches, we can lower it to \$10. Please email us at the email listed below.) Payments can be made online when you register, or we can accept cash or check in person on the first day of camp. To receive this reduced amount, after selecting the camp(s) that your child will attend this year, there will be a place on the RIGHT SIDE to enter a discount code. It is very important that you enter this code so you are not overcharged for camp! **DISCOUNT CODE: SEcamp2026**

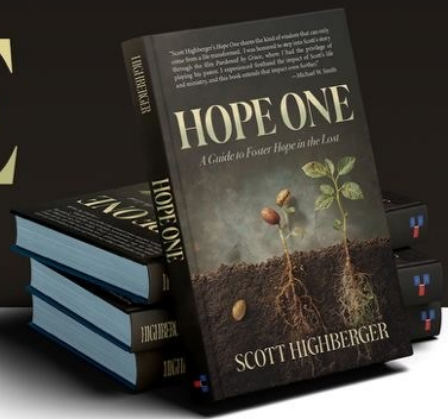

I'm reaching out today to share that the Martin County Alliance for Economic Growth, Inc. is excited to announce that registration is now open for the third year of the Legacy – Martin County Leadership Program!

Legacy is an adult leadership development program designed to identify, educate, and inspire current and emerging leaders throughout Martin County. The Alliance is partnering with professors from Indiana University and Ball State University again this year to teach the curriculum. The program provides participants with a deeper understanding of our community while helping them develop the skills, relationships, and knowledge needed to make a positive impact in Martin County.

Throughout the program, participants engage with local leaders, businesses, organizations, and government officials while exploring topics such as economic development, local government, community services, leadership, communication, and quality of place. Participants also work collaboratively on a capstone project that addresses a community need and creates a lasting impact.

Since its launch, Legacy has graduated more than 20 community leaders who are now using their knowledge and connections to strengthen Martin County. Whether you are an established professional, a business owner, a nonprofit volunteer, or simply someone who wants to become more involved in the community, Legacy offers an excellent opportunity to grow as a leader and expand your network.

The program will begin this fall and will consist of monthly sessions through the spring. The class will meet once a month on the following dates. (Mainly Friday's except for one Tuesday) October 23rd, November 6th, December 11th, January 22nd, February 19th, (Tuesday) March 2nd, and Friday, April 23rd. The cost of the program is \$350. Registration is opened until August 11th. We would love for the churches to help us get the word out about this initiative, or even if you're able identify someone in your church that maybe the church could sponsor to be apart of the leadership class. It really is a special program that brings people together that maybe may not sit at the same table normally and work together for the greater good in our community. Participants must be at least age 18.

Space is limited, and interested individuals are encouraged to apply early.
