I'm reaching out today to share that the Martin County Alliance for Economic Growth, Inc. is excited to announce that registration is now open for the third year of the Legacy – Martin County Leadership Program!

Legacy is an adult leadership development program designed to identify, educate, and inspire current and emerging leaders throughout Martin County. The Alliance is partnering with professors from Indiana University and Ball State University again this year to teach the curriculum. The program provides participants with a deeper understanding of our community while helping them develop the skills, relationships, and knowledge needed to make a positive impact in Martin County.

Throughout the program, participants engage with local leaders, businesses, organizations, and government officials while exploring topics such as economic development, local government, community services, leadership, communication, and quality of place. Participants also work collaboratively on a capstone project that addresses a community need and creates a lasting impact.

Since its launch, Legacy has graduated more than 20 community leaders who are now using their knowledge and connections to strengthen Martin County. Whether you are an established professional, a business owner, a nonprofit volunteer, or simply someone who wants to become more involved in the community, Legacy offers an excellent opportunity to grow as a leader and expand your network.

The program will begin this fall and will consist of monthly sessions through the spring. The class will meet once a month on the following dates. (Mainly Friday's except for one Tuesday) October 23rd, November 6th, December 11th, January 22nd, February 19th, (Tuesday) March 2nd, and Friday, April 23rd. The cost of the program is \$350. Registration is opened until August 11th. We would love for the churches to help us get the word out about this initiative, or even if you're able identify someone in your church that maybe the church could sponsor to be apart of the leadership class. It really is a special program that brings people together that maybe may not sit at the same table normally and work together for the greater good in our community. Participants must be at least age 18.

Space is limited, and interested individuals are encouraged to apply early.

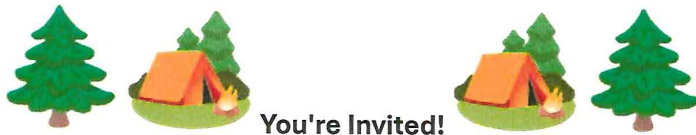

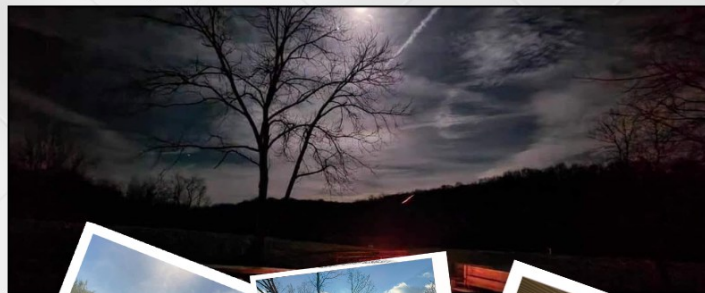
